ABOUT THE TEST

Air permeability is defined as 'the velocity of air flow passing horizontally through a test specimen, under specified conditions of test area, pressure drop and time'.


The instrument pulls air through a specimen and adjusts the flow of air gradually until a pressure drop is achieved. The measurements can be taken multiple times dependent on the standard, and a mean air permeability is expressed in the preferred units of the selected standard.






EASY TO USE TESTWISE SOFTWARE

We have developed our popular TestWise software for HydroView, housed in a 7" touchscreen that is clear and easy to read.

STANDARDS

The software comes with pre-loaded standards which inputs the test parameters for the user, and a 'Quick Test' function to start testing quickly.

Users can also modify existing standards or create their own, giving full flexibility.



SETTINGS

Multiple users can create their own profile for testing.

Volume, brightness, language and notifications can all be managed from the settings screen.

USER WARNINGS


TestWise detects if the incorrect test head is being used and warns the user. This cuts down on user error and makes testing easier.

QUICK CHANGE TEST HEADS

A quick release mechanism makes changing between the different test heads quick and easy to do.

It can be done without disconnecting the air pressure sensors, which is the case for some competitor instruments.

This will speed up testing in the laboratory, with less down time in between tests.



INTEGRATED STORAGE

AirPro can be supplied with a range of test heads.

The integrated drawer on the AirPro provides a storage area for test heads, which helps to keep laboratory areas tidy.



WHEEL BASE

The AirPro has a wheel base for easy movement. It will allow factories to take the instrument to the production area and conduct rapid testing and analysis.

LARGE ILLUMINATED TEST BED

AirPro's illuminated test bed can accommodate large samples, and is suitable for testing a variety of different materials and finished garments.

Moving between samples and taking them on and off the bed is easy to do.



NO COMPRESSED AIR REQUIRED

AirPro does not require a supply of compressed air to clean or maintain the instrument. This gives laboratories more flexibility in where they place their instrument, and makes it easier to install.

AirPro HOW TO PERFORM A TEST

1

Select your standard from the pre-loaded standards library, or create your own.



2

Insert the test head and test plate size that complies with the specific standard chosen. The software will indicate to the user which test head – or test heads - are permissible for that standard.



3

Insert the sample into the test area in between the test head and the test plate. Samples don't usually need to be cut to a specific size for this test.



4

Clamp the sample by moving the test arm down, and the test will begin automatically.



5

The touchscreen will then indicate when the specimen reading has been found, and AirPro will give an audible alert to let the user know the test is finished. Moving onto the next specimen is quick and easy.



6

You can read the results on screen, or export them to PDF or Excel. You can create custom reports with fields of your choosing.

This state-of-the-art instrument assesses the wicking ability of different fabrics. It uses an advanced imaging system to track and record the transfer of moisture through a garment.











